STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Applicant in the above styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a 320-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2E/2 of Sections 30 and 31, Township 25 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring Formation. Said spacing unit shall be dedicated to the Myox 31 State Com Well No. 501H with a surface location in the SE/4SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 31 and a bottom hole location in NE/4NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 30. The completed interval and the first and last take points for these wells will remain within the standard offset required by the Rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the costs thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the wells, and a 200% penalty for risk involved in the drilling the wells.
