 - A description and comparison of the geology of the competing well locations and a. the potential of the competing prospects to efficiently recover the oil and gas reserves underlying the property;
 - A description and comparison of the acreage used and stranded by the competing b. prospects;
 - A description and comparison of the risk associated with the competing proposals c. to explore and develop the property;
 - d. A description of the ability of each applicant to prudently operate the property and to prevent waste;
 - A description of the negotiations by each applicant prior to filing the application; e.
 - A description of each applicant's well cost estimates (AFEs) and other operational f. costs; and
 - A description of the mineral interest owned by each applicant. g.
