
**OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S
MOTION TO POSTPONE HEARING**

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”) moves to postpone the hearing scheduled for July 1, 2021, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On May 26, 2021, OCD docketed the Notice of Violation (“NOV”) issued to Petrolia Energy Corporation (“Petrolia”).
2. The Docketing Notice stated that Petrolia had failed to respond to the NOV, the informal resolution period had expired, and requested a hearing on July 1, 2021.
3. Petrolia filed an Answer on June 4, 2021.
4. OCD and Petrolia have since initiated discussion of a resolution which is sufficiently likely to result in settlement of this case to justify postponement of the hearing scheduled for July 1, 2021.
5. Petrolia consents to postponement of the hearing until August 19, 2021.

WHEREFORE, OCD respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for July 1, 2021, be postponed to August 19, 2021.
