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1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: With that I'll

- 2 call our next case. It's Number 24 on today's list.
- 3 It is Case 22178, Matador Production Company.
- 4 MS. VANCE: Good morning, Mr. Hearing
- 5 Examiner. Paula Vance with the Santa Fe Office of
- 6 Holland & Hart on behalf of the applicant, Matador
- 7 Production Company.
- 8 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Ms. Vance,
- 9 you're a little soft.
- 10 MS. VANCE: Is that better if I scoot up a
- 11 little bit?
- 12 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Yes, that's
- 13 better. Thank you.
- 14 Are there other entries of appearance,
- 15 then, for Case 22178?
- 16 Hearing none. Ms. Vance, you may proceed.
- 17 MS. VANCE: Okay. In Case 22178 Matador
- 18 seeks to pool uncommitted mineral interest within
- 19 the Bone Spring formation, Pool Code 3713 underlying
- 20 a standard 240-acre horizontal spacing unit
- 21 comprised of the south half-south half of
- 22 Section 12, and the south half of the southeast
- 23 quarter of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 27
- 24 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 25 Matador seeks to dedicate the spacing unit

1 to the proposed Bo Howard 1211 Fed Com 124H well.

- In this case we have provided the
- 3 compulsory pooling checklist as well as
- 4 self-affirmed statement and testimony of Landman
- 5 Nicholas Weeks and Geologist Andrew Parker, both of
- 6 whom have previously testified before the Division
- 7 and their credentials have been accepted as a matter
- 8 of record.
- 9 Mr. Weeks' affidavit is Exhibit C, which
- includes sub-Exhibits C1, which is the C102; C2, the
- 11 general location map; C3, the working interest owner
- 12 and overriding royal interest; C4, sample well
- 13 proposal letter with AFE; and C5, the chronology of
- 14 contact.
- 15 And I did want to note that on the C3,
- 16 Matador does not need to pool the OG, that's why you
- 17 see them not listed in the notice.
- 18 Following this, is Mr. Parker's affidavit,
- 19 which is Exhibit D and includes sub-Exhibits D1, the
- locator map; D2, structure map; and D3, the cross
- 21 section map.
- In this case Mr. Parker did not observe
- 23 any faulting, pinch-outs or other geologic
- 24 impediments to the horizontal drilling of this well.
- 25 Lastly our Exhibit E, affidavit of notice

1 with sample letters that were timely mailed on

- 2 April 1st, 2022.
- 3 In Exhibit F, Affidavit of Notice of
- 4 Publication which was timely published on
- 5 March 31st, 2022.
- 6 And I did also want to note we filed an
- 7 updated Exhibit E to reflect that it was Adam Rankin
- 8 who completed notice.
- 9 And with that unless there are any
- 10 questions, I would ask that all exhibits and
- 11 sub-exhibits be admitted into the record and the
- 12 Case 22178 be take under advisement by the Division
- 13 at this time.
- 14 Thank you.
- 15 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 16 Mr. Rose-Coss, any questions?
- 17 MR. ROSE-COSS: It sounds like there
- 18 wasn't any issue with notice, then. It was timely
- 19 and all the party locatable.
- MS. VANCE: Yes, that's correct. Well,
- 21 yes, that is correct.
- MR. ROSE-COSS: Okay. Just verifying that
- 23 and no additional questions from me, Mr. Brancard.
- Thank you, Ms. Vance.
- MS. VANCE: Absolutely.

1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you. I

- 2 guess I need to ask the question Mr. Garcia would
- 3 normally ask, which is just trying to make sure
- 4 there is no stranded acreage here. And I was
- 5 looking at your Exhibit D2.
- 6 MS. VANCE: Okay. I'm there,
- 7 Mr. Examiner.
- 8 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: It looks like
- 9 in -- I don't know which section it is, but the
- 10 section to the left you're going across the section
- and then leaving, I believe, an 80-acre unit to the
- 12 west. It does appear that somebody has been
- drilling wells to the north across the entire
- 14 section.
- 15 MS. VANCE: I would have to get with
- 16 Matador and ask that question but I'm happy to
- 17 follow-up with them and reach back out to the
- 18 Division with an answer for you on that.
- 19 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. That
- 20 will be helpful, yes, thank you.
- 21 And so that ends my question and I will
- 22 then, any other interested persons for Case 22178?
- 23 Hearing none, the exhibits will be
- 24 admitted into the record.
- 25 Case 22178 will be taken under advisement
