1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Number 14 we have  
2 listed as a Commission Case 22309, but I believe it's  
3 actually Division Cases 21651, 21773. Let's start with Spur  
4 Energy Partners.

5 MR. RANKIN: Morning, Mr. Examiner, Adam Rankin  
6 appearing on behalf of Spur, Santa Fe office of Holland &  
7 Hart.

8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.  
9 Longfellow Energy.

10 MR. LAWTON: Morning, Mr. Hearing Examiner, Troy  
11 Lawton with Montgomery & Andrews on behalf of Longfellow  
12 Energy.

13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.  
14 ConocoPhillips has an entry.

15 MS. HARDY: Dana Hardy with Hinkle Shanor on  
16 behalf of ConocoPhillips.

17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there  
18 any other entries for either Commission case 22309 or  
19 Division cases 21651, 21733.

20 (No audible response.)

21 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none. So as  
22 I understand, we have a remand from the Commission, and the  
23 parties have worked out some sort of arrangement here,  
24 possibly even to get rid of a gorgeous Division order that  
25 we issued several months back, but I won't take it

1 personally.

2 MR. RANKIN: (Inaudible) confer, but essentially  
3 the agreement is that Longfellow will -- and, again, we are  
4 looking for the Division's guidance, but essentially our  
5 proposal is that Longfellow will dismiss its underlying  
6 application, move the Division to revoke the existing order,  
7 and then we would ask the Division to enter an order  
8 approving Spur's case in -- application in Case 21733.

9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So I believe  
10 this order R21834?

11 MR. RANKIN: That's correct.

12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And so  
13 21651 would get dismissed, and then 21733 would go forward.  
14 Is that correct?

15 MR. RANKIN: That's correct.

16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So 21733,  
17 whose case is that?

18 MR. RANKIN: That's Spur's case.

19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So the  
20 big question, Mr. Rankin, is -- and you may need to look at  
21 the record, but is the record before the Division sufficient  
22 and up to date for the Division to go ahead without  
23 reopening the record? That's the question. Do you need to  
24 update a checklist, anything you need to do that's what we  
25 need to know.

1           Because what we are basically, I hear being  
2 proposed, and maybe I'm reading into your thoughts here, is  
3 a joint motion from the parties to revoke or rescind the  
4 order R-21834, dismiss Division Case 21651, and then request  
5 that the Division issue an order approving 21733 -- is that  
6 correct -- based on the record that exists now.

7           MR. RANKIN: That's correct. I think that's  
8 possible. I don't think there is anything that would impede  
9 or prevent that. I will double check, Mr. Examiner, with  
10 Longfellow and confirm that the record is complete and  
11 efficient and no updates are required. Once we do that, we  
12 will, at your direction, file a joint motion to do just as  
13 you have outlined.

14           HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right.  
15 Mr. Lawton.

16           MR. LAWTON: Longfellow agrees with everything  
17 that Spur's counsel has proposed with the addition of asking  
18 the hearing examiner to withdraw Longfellow's appearance in  
19 the Aid North application.

20           HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Well, you can  
21 just file something to do that. We need to keep that out of  
22 this process, just file a separate piece of paper. So, Ms.  
23 Hardy, any comments from Conoco?

24           MS. HARDY: ConocoPhillips has no objection to  
25 what's being discussed.

1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Okay. So  
2 would it be possible then to come up with this joint motion  
3 in the next few days, Mr. Rankin?

4 MR. RANKIN: The only, the only hiccup there, Mr.  
5 Examiner, is that Ms. Shaheen is out of office. She is on  
6 vacation, and she would like to have a chance to review  
7 whatever joint proposal or motion we submit, but that's the  
8 only impediment or delay that would be imposed is that we  
9 would need to wait for Ms. Shaheen to return and give her a  
10 chance to review and confer with her client.

11 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Mr. Lawton, is  
12 that correct?

13 MR. LAWTON: That's correct.

14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And when would Ms.  
15 Shaheen be back?

16 MR. LAWTON: She comes back Thursday the 11th.

17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So here  
18 is what I'm tentatively going to do. I'm tentatively going  
19 to continue this case to September 1, okay? And you all  
20 need to file motions for continuances not on the Commission  
21 case, but -- let's forget about 22309 -- but on 651, 733 and  
22 then hopefully there will be a motion for us to continue on  
23 September 1. Does that sound workable?

24 MR. RANKIN: Indeed we will endeavor to get that  
25 done. That shouldn't be a problem with the time frames. We

1 will file a joint motion and in the meantime file  
2 continuances on September 1.

3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. And I may  
4 issue a scheduling order just so that there's something in  
5 the file. Any other comments on these cases 22309, 21561,  
6 21733.

7 (No audible response.)

8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, these  
9 cases are continued to September 1.
