1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Next we are on items  
2 10 through 13, these are 22605, 22606, 22607, 22608, EGL  
3 Resources.

4 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce representing  
5 EGL.

6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And just to make  
7 things confusing, EOG Resources.

8 MR. FELDEWERT: Good morning, Mr. Examiner,  
9 Michael Feldewert of the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart.

10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other  
11 interested persons for Case 22605, 606, 607, 608.

12 (No audible response.)

13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none,  
14 there's -- there are cases allegedly appearing on the  
15 September 1 docket from EOG, Mr. Feldewert.

16 MR. FELDEWERT: No longer allegedly,  
17 Mr. Brancard. They have been filed and they are case number  
18 23007, 23008 and 23009. It would be the EOG Goldfinger  
19 Wells.

20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Seriously?

21 MR. FELDEWERT: Seriously.

22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Goldfinger versus  
23 Moonraker?

24 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes.

25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Those are competing

1 with the four cases I have just listed here from EGL. Is  
2 that correct, Mr. Feldewert?

3 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, sir.

4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And it is your goal  
5 to have all these cases be heard at the same time on  
6 September 1; is that correct?

7 MR. FELDEWERT: On whatever docket is available  
8 before the Division, yes.

9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Mr.  
10 Bruce?

11 MR. BRUCE: I agree with Mr. Feldewert. I mean,  
12 I -- the parties have been in discussions for quite some  
13 time, and EOG finally filed its applications. I do believe  
14 they are still in discussions, but we would like this put on  
15 the next available docket that the Division can afford to  
16 hear the case.

17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So for a  
18 contested docket then, I guess really October 6 is what we  
19 are looking at.

20 MR. BRUCE: I can't do that, Mr. Examiner. The  
21 reason why is I am in town that date, but in the afternoon I  
22 have a couple of medical appointments that I have been -- I  
23 had to book out three months in advance with the medical  
24 system being what it is these days, and they are mid  
25 afternoon appointments, and I don't mind starting the

1 hearing if that's necessary, but I would have to leave that  
2 afternoon to get to the ophthalmologist and another doctor.

3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Well, you know, let's  
4 take a risk here and let's just do it then September 1.  
5 Will that work, Mr. Bruce?

6 MR. BRUCE: That would work.

7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: We already have EOG  
8 cases on that docket. Obviously, if you all are not quite  
9 ready, you can file for a continuance.

10 MR. BRUCE: And I have filed continuances, Mr.  
11 Examiner, to the September 1 docket because Mr. Feldewert  
12 said that his cases would be on that docket, so all the  
13 continuances are already in place.

14 MS. SALVIDREZ: I need to check that because I  
15 think you filed another motion without --

16 MR. BRUCE: I will double check.

17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. For the  
18 record that was Marlene.

19 MR. BRUCE: Oh.

20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: We will schedule it  
21 then for a contested hearing on September 1. These will be  
22 cases 22605, 606, 607, 608, and we will merge them with EOG  
23 cases 23007, 008, 009. Are there any other interested  
24 persons in these cases today?

25 (No audible response.)

1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: We will issue a  
2 prehearing order then for September 1. Thank you.

3 MR. FELDEWERT: Thank you.

4 (Docket hearings held.)

5 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, before I forget, I did  
6 check on those Moonraker and Goldfinger cases, I did check  
7 on July 20, although I recognize a status conference would  
8 heard on August 4, I did file a motion which was approved by  
9 the Division to continue EGL's cases to September 1.

10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. You are on top  
11 of the game, Mr. Bruce.

12 MS. SALVIDREZ: Sorry, this is Marlene. I just  
13 researched that and he did file that, but that was to put  
14 them on today's docket.

15 MR. BRUCE: No, no, no, no, no, no. I apologize,  
16 but, no. If you look at the last paragraph, I requested  
17 they be -- they be placed on the September 1 docket. The  
18 final sentence I said that I know that there is a request  
19 for a status conference, and I said that's okay, but I did  
20 move to continue them to September 1.

21 MS. SALVIDREZ: Okay. So they wouldn't have been  
22 put on today's docket if you didn't file that continuance.  
23 So I will go ahead and move them, but you didn't have them  
24 on today's docket, you hadn't filed a continuance from the  
25 last hearing. So I will do that this time, but you all need

1 to file continuances for the docket you request for them to  
2 be on.

3 MR. BRUCE: Okay, I apologize.

4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Thank you.
