The following case was continued from the July 13, 2023 Commission hearing:

**Case No. 23649:** Targa Northern Delaware LLC ("Targa") seeks authorization to drill and operate a class II acid gas injection (AGI) well, the Red Hills AGI #3 well, at Targa's gas processing facility ("Facility") in Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed redundant well (Red Hills AGI #3) will be a vertical well with a surface location of approximately 3,116 feet from the north line (FNL) and 1,159 feet from the east line (FEL) in Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The Red Hills AGI #3 well will inject waste carbon dioxide and hydrogen sulfide into the Bell Canyon and Cherry Canyon formation from approximately 5,700 feet to 7,600 feet. The maximum surface pressure will not exceed 1,767 psi with a maximum daily injection volume of thirteen (13) million standard cubic feet per day (MMSCFD). The proposed well will serve as a disposal well for treated acid gas at the Facility. The Well is located approximately 20 miles west of Jal, New Mexico.

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks to amend Commission Order R-111-P, adopted in 1988 under Case 9316, to add anti-collision measures, to modify the well casing and cementing requirements, to provide additional notification requirements to potash operators, to provide for subsidence monitoring, and to adopt other proposed changes for oil and gas development in the Known Potash Leasing Area located in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico. ## Google's comeback trail


Google appears to have patched the cracks in its digital ad empire at the same time its corporate parent Alphabet is clamping down on expenses — a combination that has helped restore its investment luster.

Alphabet's slump began as a pandemic-driven boom in demand for digital services and products faded, and it worsened amid concerns that Google was being outmaneuvered in artificial intelligence, or "AI" — a breakthrough expected to reshape the future.

Google allayed those fears when it unveiled its strategy for deploying AI in its dominant search in early May and then proceeded to snap out of an unprecedented decline in its ad sales. After suffering year-over-year drops in its ad revenue in consecutive quarters for the first time in its history, Google posted a 3% gain in the April-June period.

At the same time, Alphabet has been reining in expenses in an effort to boost profits. The streamlining included mass layoffs that shrank Alphabet's workforce by 5% from March to June. Those factors have help lift Alphabet's stock price by nearly 50% so far this year.
