

Mewbourne Oil Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a 160-acre non-standard well spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Yeso formation comprised of the W2W/2 of Section 21, Township 30 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests (i) from the surface to the top of the Yeso formation underlying the SW4SW/4 of Section 21 to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit and (ii) the Yeso formation underlying the W2W/2 of Section 21 to form a non-standard 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Pine Box 21 MD Fed. Com. Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SW4SW/4 and a terminus in the NW4NW/4 of Section 21. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, October 13, 2011 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P. O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The units are located approximately 5 miles southwest of Seven Rivers, New Mexico.
