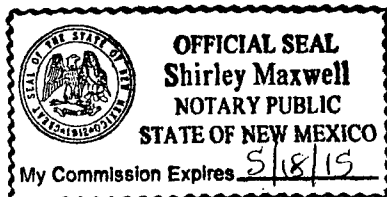

CASE 14624 APPLICATION of Nadel and Gussman, L.L.C. for a Non-Standard Spacing and Proration Unit and Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order consolidating the four 40-acre spacing units within the E2W/2 of Section 7, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, and designating the consolidated units as a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit for a well locations in the Glorieta Yesso formation for Applicant's horizontal drilling project area. Applicant further seeks the compulsory pooling of all interests from the surface to the base of the Glorieta Yesso formation underlying the E2W/4 of this section to be dedicated to its Long Branch Well No. 2 (API #30-015-8819) to be drilled horizontally from a surface location (Unit C) 330 feet FNL and 2310 feet FWL to a bottom hole location (Unit N) 330 feet FNL and 2310 feet FWL within this section and to a depth sufficient to test the Glorieta Yesso formation, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Also to be considered will be the costs of the drilling and completing this well and the allocation of the costs thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of the applicant as the operator of the well, a risk charge of 200% for the risk involved in this well. This unit is located approximately four miles northwest of Lakewood, New Mexico.
