STATEMENT OF CASE

Applicant seeks an order approving the Lennox State Exploratory Unit, comprising of All Section 32, the N/2 of Section 33, All of Section 34 and the N/2 of Section 35, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, NMPM in Lea County. Caza Petroleum is proposing to drill the pilot hole for the Lennox State Unit #1H, an upper 2nd Bone Spring sand horizontal test, at a legal surface location in either Section 32 or Section 33, T22S, R35E. The Lennox State Unit #1H pilot hole will be drilled to an approximate depth of 11,400', into the top of the Wolfcamp formation. While several zones of interest will be penetrated vertically and evaluated for future development potential, the targeted reservoir for the horizontal leg of the Lennox State Unit #1H is the upper 2nd Bone Spring sand. This area is located in central eastern Lea County, approximately 15 miles southwest of Eunice, New Mexico.
