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STATEMENT OF CASE

Applicant seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation, comprised of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 27, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, which will be the project area for the Forehand Ranch 27 State Well No. 1-H, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 252 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit B), to a bottom-hole terminus at a location 330 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit O) of said Section 27; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit.


