CASE NO. 14812: Application of COG Operating LLC for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.

To: **Wanda Lawrence, or her successors, heirs and devisees.**

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order: (1) creating a non-standard 160-acre, more or less, oil spacing and proration unit in the Yeso formation, comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M. Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying this proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit. This proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Arabian 6 Fee No. 2H well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 150 feet from the South line and 1700 feet from the West line of said Section 6 (Unit N) to a bottom hole terminus at a location 330 feet from the North line and 1700 feet from the West line of said Section 6 (Unit C). The completed interval for this well will be within the 330-foot standard offset required by the rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 3 miles northwest of Lakewood, New Mexico.
