STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving an 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Delaware formation comprised of the W/2W/2 of Section 35, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests (i) from the surface to the base of the Delaware formation underlying the SW/4SW/4 of Section 35 to form a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit, and (ii) the Delaware formation underlying the W/2W/2 of Section 35 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Layla 35 MD Fee Com. Well No. 1, a

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horizontal well with a surface location in the SW/4SW/4, and a terminus in the NW/4NW/4, of Section 35. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
