WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 9:31 a.m.:

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CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: The next cause before the Commission is Case Number 13,351, the de novo Application of Edge Petroleum Exploration Company to restrict the effect of the special rules and regulations for the Dos Hermanos Gas Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

Again, Commissioner Brooks [sic], would you explain to the Commission where we are on this case?

This case was heard at the MR. BROOKS: Commission's March meeting, and following the conclusion of the testimony the Commission met in executive session and instructed me as to the decision that the Commission believed was appropriate in that case, which was basically to enter an order granting the compulsory pooling as requested by Edge Petroleum -- I'm sorry, not compulsory pooling, I misspoke -- granting the rule change as requested by Edge Petroleum, which would remove the peripheral area around the Dos Hermanos Pool from the operation of the pool rules, with one important exception, and that was that the wells that might be drilled within the peripheral area and completed in the Morrow zone would have to be located at least 1250 feet from the outer boundary of the Dos Hermanos Pool. Otherwise, the spacing

in that area would go back to the statewide rules.

And so that was not the position advocated by either party but it was the position that the Commission determined was appropriate. And I believe that is what the order does, and the order has been presented for your signature.

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I believe you misspoke and said 1250 feet instead of 1650 feet.

MR. BROOKS: I am sorry, Commissioner, you are correct. 1650 feet. I was fumbling around trying to find a copy of the order. There was not one in the briefing book, and I didn't have one, so I spoke from memory, and I'm sure that you are correct. 1650 feet from the outer boundary of the Dos Hermanos Pool.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Commissioner Bailey, that's my recollection; is that yours?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, it is.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: And have you had a chance to review the proposed order?

COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I expect to sign it.

CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, and I took have reviewed the proposed order and believe that it indicates the decision of the Commission and will sign it at this time.

Let the record reflect that the order in Case

Number 13,351 has been signed and is part of the record. 1 2 3 The next cause before the CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: 4 Commission is Case Number 13,357, final action in the de 5 novo Application of Matrix New Mexico Holdings, LLC, for 6 compulsory pooling in Lea County, New Mexico. 7 Counsel Brooks, you're up again. 8 MR. BROOKS: Okay, I believe that the parties 9 have requested that this case be dismissed, and Commission 10 11 Secretary Davidson has prepared an order doing that. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: Okay, Commissioner Bailey, 12 13 have you had a chance to review the order? 14 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, and I expect to sign 15 it. CHAIRMAN FESMIRE: 16 I too have reviewed it and 17 will sign it. 18 Let the record reflect that the order dismissing 19 Case Number 13,357, the de novo Application of Matrix New Mexico Holdings, LLC, for compulsory pooling in Lea County, 20 21 New Mexico, has been signed and is part of the record. 22 (Thereupon, these proceedings were concluded at 23 9:36 a.m.) 24 25
