APPLICATION FOR COMPULSORY POOLING

LIME ROCK RESOURCES II-A, L.P. applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface of the earth to an approximate depth of 4,200 feet sufficient to test the Yeso Formation underlying the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (Section 7). In support of this application, Applicant states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7, and has the right to drill thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to drill its Kaiser 7 K Well No. 4 well as an infill well in the Red Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool to be located at a standard well location in Unit Letter K having a surface location 2140 FSL and 1475 FWL of Section 7, and a bottom hole location of 2310 FSL and 1650 FWL.
3. Applicant seeks to dedicate the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7 to the well to form a standard 40 acre spacing and proration unit as to the Yeso Formation and for any other formations or pools encountered for developed on 40 or less acre spacing within the vertical extent of the well.
4. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all

other mineral interest owners in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7 for the purposes set forth herein.

4. Certain mineral owners have failed or refused to join in the drilling of the proposed well, therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7 pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests as proposed in this application will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. A. Pooling all mineral interests in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7 from the surface of the earth to a depth sufficient to test the Yeso formation;
- B. Designating Applicant as the operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and,
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

Application of Lime Rock Resources II-A, L.P. for approval of compulsory well, Eddy County, New Mexico; Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface of the earth to an approximate depth of 4,200 feet sufficient to test the Yeso formation with its Kaiser 7 K Well No. 4 underlying the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The subject well will be located approximately 7 miles southwest of Loco Hills, New Mexico.

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
