To: Damson Institutional Oil & Gas Corporation and Union Pacific Resources Company: Edge Petroleum Exploration Company has filed an application for compulsory pooling with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (Case No. 13484), seeking an order pooling all mineral interests underlying the following described acreage in Section 28, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM: The S/2 to form a 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Southeast Lusk-Atoka Gas Pool and the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool; and the SW/4 to form a 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Lusk-Strawn Pool. The units are to be dedicated to the South Lusk 28 "H" Fed. Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 28. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Edge Petroleum Operating Company as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on July 14, 2005 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The units are located approximately 6 miles north-northwest of Halfway, New Mexico.
