**MOTION TO REOPEN CASE NO. 14911 FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL NOTICE**

COG OPERATING, LLC, ("COG") through its undersigned attorneys, hereby requests that the Oil Conservation Division reopen Case No. 14911 for the purpose of providing additional notice to an interest owners recently discovered in the N/2 N/2 of Section 1, Township 19 South, Range 25 East. In support of this motion, COG states:

1. In December of 2012, the Division entered Order No. R-13669 creating a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Section 1 in the Penasco-San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool (Pool Code 50270) and pooling the known mineral interests in this pool underlying this unit.

2. COG has recently discovered an additional mineral owner that owns a small interest in the N/2 N/2 of Section 1 that was not provided notice of the hearings in Case No. 14911.


3. In order to provide proper notice to this additional mineral owner and to bring his interest under the terms of the Order No. R-13669, COG requests that Case No. 14911 be re-opened and called for hearing at the next available examiner docket.

WHEREFORE, COG Operating, LLC requests that Case No. 14911 be re-opened and set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 21, 2013.
