Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Gloria Yeso formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools of formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Super Chief Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SE/4SW/4 and a terminus in the NE/4NW/4 of Section 24. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision designation of applicant as operator of the well and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, September 20, 2012 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87503. As an interest owner in the well unit, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 4.172 miles southeast of Atoka, New Mexico.
