

4. Applicant requests that the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Culebra Bluff-Bone Spring Pool be abolished, and that the pool be governed in the future by the Division's statewide rules.
5. **Applicant requests that all existing 80 acre well units be grandfathered in, unless an operator desires to change spacing for a well unit.**
6. Approval of this application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
