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APPLICATION OF CHI OPERATING, INC. TO AMEND ORDER NO. R-13262, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Chi Operator, Inc., for its application, states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the Benson Delaware Unit (the "Unit Area"), which covers the following federal lands located in Eddy County, New Mexico:

Township 19 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M.
Section 1: NE 1/4 SW 1/4, S 1/2 SW 1/4, and W 1/2 SE 1/4
Section 11: E 1/2 NE 1/4 and SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 12: NW 1/4 and N 1/2 SW 1/4

Containing 560.00 acres.

2. Division Order No. R-13262, as amended, approved the Unit Area and an enhanced recovery project for the Unit Area in the Brushy Canyon formation.

3. Division Order No. R-13262 approved (among others) the following injection wells for the Unit Area:

Table with 3 columns: Well Name, Surface Location, Bottom Hole Location. Rows include Munchkin No. 14W, 16W, 17W, 18W, 19W, 22W with their respective surface and bottom hole locations.

4. The Munchkin Well Nos. 16W, 17W, 18W, and 22W have not yet been drilled. The Munchkin Well Nos. 14W and 19W are producing wells that have not yet been converted to production.

5. The United States Bureau of Land Management has requested that the wells listed in paragraph 3 above be removed from the list of approved injection wells.


6. Applicant hereby requests that the Munchkin Well Nos. 14W, 16W, 17W, 18W, 19W, and 22W be deleted from the list of approved injection wells in Division Order No. R-13626.

7. Applicant requests that future injection wells within the Unit Area be approved administratively by the Division as provided in NMAC 19.15.26.8.A.

8. Approval of this application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter an order approving the relief requested above.

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case No. 15019 :

Application of Chi Operating, Inc. to amend Division Order No. R-13262, Eddy County, New Mexico. Division Order No. R-13262, as amended, unitized all mineral interests in the Brushy Canyon member of the Delaware formation (Benson-Delaware Pool) underlying parts of Sections 1, 11, and 12, Township 19 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., comprising 560.00 acres of federal lands, to form the Benson Delaware Unit. The order also approved an enhanced recovery project for the Benson Delaware Unit, and approved certain injection wells for the Benson Delaware Unit. Applicant requests that Division Order No. R-13262 be amended so that the Munchkin Well Nos. 14W, 16W, 17W, 18W, 19W, and 22W be deleted from the list of approved injection wells. Applicant requests that future injection wells within the Unit Area be approved administratively by the Division as provided in NMAC 19.15.26.8.A. The Benson Delaware Unit is centered approximately 10 miles south-southeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico.

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
