



To: J. C. Johnson, Individually and as Personal Representative of the Estate of Dorothy M. Johnson, Jack G. Roberts, and Helen G. Newell, or their heirs, devisees, successor, and assigns: Marshall & Winston, Inc. seeks an order approving a 320-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S/2 of Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2 of Section 3 to form a non-standard 320-acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 160 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the East Lusk-Bone Spring Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the TJG Fed. Com. 3 Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location 400 feet from the south line and 330 feet from the east line, and a terminus 400 feet from the south line and 330 feet from the west line, of Section 3. The surface and bottom hole locations are unorthodox under the special pool rules for the East Lusk-Bone Spring Pool, and applicant seeks approval of same. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Monday, March 7, 2013 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 12 miles south of Maljamar, New Mexico.
