5 application of Cimarex Energy Company for a nonstandard
6 oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling in
7 Chaves County, New Mexico.

8 That appears to be all that's been listed
9 on our docket.

11 Commission today?

12 MR. BRANCARD: Madam Chair, if I may, just
13 for a moment, I would note that the Commissioners have
14 now heard that Gabrielle Gerholt will be leaving the
15 State this Friday, I believe --

18 Holland & Hart. We have a chance to say good-bye to
19 Gabrielle, at least from this side of the aisle.

20 CHAIRPERSON DIXON: And we look forward to
21 working with you in a year.

22 MR. BRANCARD: And if you have not met our
23 newest attorney in the Division, he is Gabriel Wade, who
24 joins us from the Office of the State Engineer. And
25 he's been with us for a few months now, and he's getting

2 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: And we have enjoyed
3 working with you on a Commission level, and I'm sure on
4 the commission level, we will have the same rapport.

5 MR. WADE: Appreciate that.

6 COMMISSIONER BALCH: And you're okay, too,
7 Mr. Feldewert (laughter). Nice job.

8 (Laughter.)

9 CHAIRPERSON BAILEY: If there is nothing
10 else before the Commission today, do I hear a motion to
11 adjourn?

12 COMMISSIONER BALCH: I'll make a motion to
13 adjourn.

14 COMMISSIONER WARNELL: I second that
15 motion.


