STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT:

Trek Resources, Inc., in accordance with Section 70-1-17.C seeks a compulsory pooling order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Drinkard formation underlying the NE/4SW/4 of Section 30, T16S, R39E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any production for any and all formations/pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including but not limited to the Lower Clearfork-Drinkard Pool. This unit is to be dedicated to its Stephenson Well No. 1 that is to be drilled at a standard well location in Unit K of this section. Also to be considered will be the costs of the drilling and completing this well and the allocation of the costs thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Trek Resources, Inc. as the operator of the well and, pursuant to Commission Order R-11992, a risk charge of 200% for the risk involved in this well. Applicant proposes to submit its evidence by affidavit in accordance with Division Rule 1207.A

Trek Resources, Inc. requests that this application be processed in accordance with Division Rule 1607(A)(1)(b) and accordingly will submit it evidence by affidavit.
