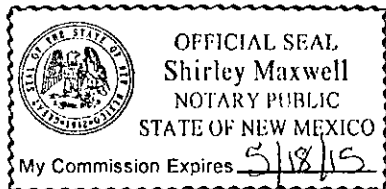

RSC Resources Limited Partnership has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 15, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and in the following manner: The N/2 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration

unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing with in that vertical extent, the NE/4 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent, and the SW/4NE/4 to form a standard 40-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Ana Com. Well No. 1 to be re-entered at an orthodox location in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 15. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-entering and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of a Guardian Operating Corp. as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in re-entering and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, July 11, 2013 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well units, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
