MOTION FOR WRITTEN ORDER SHORTENING THE TIME FOR NOTICE

Pursuant to 19.15.14.1202.B NMAC (Rule 1202.B), the Oil Conservation Division (Division) moves for a written order shortening the time for publication of the Oil Conservation Commission (Commission) docket for October 13, 2005.

1. Rule 19.15.14.1202.A(2) NMAC (Rule 1202.A(2)) requires the Division to publish notice of rulemaking on the applicable Commission docket, which the Commission Clerk shall send by regular or electronic mail not less than 20 days prior to the hearing to all who have requested such notice. Rule 1202.B became effective on September 30, 2005. However, the same time requirement appears in the prior version of the procedural rules, at 19.15.14.1201.B(4) NMAC.

2. Rule 19.15.14.1207(B) (Rule 1207(B)), also effective September 30, 2005, requires the Division to deliver notice of adjudicatory hearings by regular or electronic mail at least 20 days prior to the hearing to each person who has requested such notice. The prior version of this rule did not provide a deadline for such notice. See 19.15.14.1204.B NMAC.

3. The Commission Clerk keeps a list of all persons requesting notice of rulemaking or adjudicatory proceedings, and sends a copy of the Commission docket to those persons prior to the hearing date.

4. The Commission docket for October 13, 2005 was not sent to the persons on the list until Monday, September 26, 2005. The docket should have been sent by Friday, September 23, 2005 in order to meet the 20-day deadline.

5. The October 13, 2005 docket contains two rulemaking proceedings (final action on Case 13555 and the hearing in Case 13564) and two adjudicatory proceedings (Cases 13274 and 13480).

6. The application in Case 13564, the enforcement and compliance rules, was filed on September 2, 2005, in sufficient time to meet all notice deadlines under either the current or the prior version of the procedural rules.

7. The Division met all other notice deadlines for Case 13564.

8. In addition to the notice required by the procedural rules, the Division also conducted a stakeholders' meeting on September 21, 2005 regarding Case 13564. Notice of the meeting was posted on the Division's website, letters were sent to each person who attended meetings on House Memorial 39, and notice was e-mailed to every person or entity on a list kept by the Division's Environmental Bureau of entities interested in environmental regulations. A copy of the letter announcing the stakeholders' meeting,

with a copy of the list of attendees at the meetings on House Memorial 39, is attached as Exhibit A. A copy of the e-mail sent to persons and entities on the list kept by the Environmental Bureau is attached as Exhibit B.

9. Also in addition to the notice required by the procedural rules, the Division posted on the web its brief supporting the proposed rulemaking, and sent electronic notice on September 16, 2005 to the same list that is used for sending the docket. A copy of that e-mail is attached as Exhibit C.


10. Rule 1202.B provides that in cases of emergency, the division director may shorten the time limits set out in Rule 1202 by written order.

11. The Division requests that the time limit under Rule 1202.A(2) be shortened, making timely the Division's mailing of the docket on September 26, 2005.

12. The individuals who are entitled to notice by the mailing of the docket will not be prejudiced by this change: they received notice of the upcoming rulemaking by receiving the Division's brief in support of the application on September 16, 2005.

13. Allowing the Division to proceed to hearing on October 13, 2005 will benefit the Division and all parties who have worked to meet the deadlines required for this hearing, and who are prepared to present their cases.

For the foregoing reasons, the Division respectfully requests that the Commission issue a written order pursuant to Rule 1202.B shortening the time limit set by Rule 1202.A(2) for the Commission hearing scheduled for October 13, 2005, and recognizing as timely the mailing of the October 13, 2005 docket on September 26, 2005.
