Application of Nadel and Gussman Heyco, LLC for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Glorieta-Yeso formation comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Section 9, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM.
