Ladies and Gentlemen:

Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") hereby proposes drilling a horizontal 2nd Bone Spring sand test in Section 11, T-18-S, R-31-E, Eddy County, New Mexico. The well will be called the Tamano "11" NC Fed COM #1-H well and will have a surface location 150' FSL & 2,310' FWL and a bottom hole location 330' FNL & 2,310' FWL of said Section 11. We anticipate drilling to a vertical depth of approximately 8,100' where horizontal drilling operations will commence intended to land the well horizontal in the 2nd Bone Spring formation at a vertical depth of approximately 8,577'. We would then continue drilling horizontally to the north in the 2nd Bone Spring Sand formation to the bottom hole location at a total measured depth of 13,165' and a vertical depth of 8,569'.

Because there is no Operating Agreement in place that would govern operations for this project, Mewbourne proposes forming a 320 acre working interest unit covering the W/2 of said Section 11 limited to those depths from the base of the 2nd Bone Spring carbonate down to the base of the Wolfcamp formation. Based upon the Title Opinion previously rendered for this project, Ard Oil, Ltd. ("Ard") owns an undivided 3.54197% contractual interest in the SW/4 of said Section 11. Accordingly, Ard would have a 1.77083% working interest in the proposed unit and well.

Enclosed are duplicate original AFE well cost estimates for this well, a 1989 Model Form JOA covering the W/2 of said Section 11 limited to those depths from the base of the 2nd Bone Spring carbonate down to the base of the Wolfcamp formation along with an extra set of signature pages to the JOA. To make your election to join in the proposed well and unit, please execute and return one of the enclosed AFEs along with the extra set of signature pages to the JOA. Please note that Mewbourne's AFEs provide all participants the opportunity to opt out of the "Extra Expense Well Control Insurance" that Mewbourne purchases for each well it drills. To opt out of this insurance, please be sure to sign the AFE a second time at the bottom of each AFE. If you do opt out, you must provide evidence that you have adequate well control insurance.






