Case No. 15090: Application of COG Operating, LLC for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W1/2W2/2 of Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation, Atoka-Glorietta-Yeso Pool, underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Arabian-61-Fee 10H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW1/4SW1/4 (Unit M) of Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 26 East to a standard bottom hole location in the SW1/4SW1/4 (Unit M) of Section 6, Township 19 South, Range 26 East. The completed interval for this well will commence in the NW1/4NW1/4 (Unit D) of Section 6 and remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating, LLC as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 8 miles southwest of Dayton, New Mexico.
