STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order expanding the boundaries of the North Hay Hollow-Bone Spring Pool (Pool Code 30216). The Pool was established by Division Order No. R-8065, and currently includes the following acreage:

Township 25 South, Range 27 East, N:M.P.M.

Section 26: NE/4

Additional wells have been placed in the Pool by the Division, but its boundaries have not been formally expanded. The Division has informed applicant that its proposed expansion of the Pool includes the following acreage:

Township 25 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 22: All Section 23: All Section 24: All Section 25: All Section 26: E/2

Township 25 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 7: E/2Section 8: All Section 17: W/2Section 18: All Section 19: All Section 20: W/2Section 29: W/2Section 30: All

In Case No. 15,076 applicant sought an order establishing special rules and regulations for the Pool, including a depth bracket allowable of 375 barrels of oil per day for a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit. The Division has requested that the Pool be expanded so that all wells in the Pool will be covered by any special pool rules which may be enacted.
