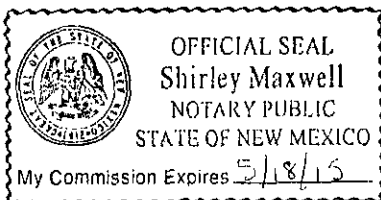

Mexico Oil Conservation
Division seeking an order
pooling all mineral inter-
ests in the Wolfcamp for-
mation underlying the E/2
of Section 22, Township
26 South, Range 27 East,
NMPM, Eddy County, New
Mexico, to form a stand-
ard 320 acre gas spacing
and proration unit for all
pools or formations de-
veloped on a 320 acre
spacing within that verti-
cal extent. The unit is to
be dedicated to the Owl
Draw 22 W1 AP Fed. Com.
Well No. 1H, a horizontal
well with a surface loca-
tion in the SE/4SE/4 of
adjoining Section 15, and
a terminus in the
