Chevron seeks authority to surface commingle production from the Bone Spring formation, Red Hills; Bone Spring North Pool produced from the Gramma Ridge 14 24 34 #1H well (API No. 30-025-41811) and the Gramma Ridge 14 24 34 #2H well (API No. 30-025-41731) located in Section 14, Township 24 South, Range 34 East.
