

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case No. 15233 (Readvertised)

Application of Harvey E. Yates Company for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit, compulsory pooling, and an unorthodox oil well location, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order approving a 240-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2SE/4 of Section 22 and E/2E/2 of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 or 80 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Mallon 27 Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location 330 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 27, and a terminus 2310 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 22. The location is unorthodox under regulations for the Lea-Bone Spring Pool. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 11-1/2 miles west-southwest of Oil Center, New Mexico.

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
