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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

COG Operating LLC seeks an order (1) creating a 160-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2W/2 of Section 4, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage (Red Hill; Upper Bone Spring Shale pool (97900)). This proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the proposed Monet Fed Com No. 10H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4NW/4 (Lot 4)

to a standard bottom hole location in SW/4SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 4. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.


