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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

COG Operating LLC for an order (1) creating a 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 3, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation (Atoka; Glorieta Yeso Pool (3250)). This proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the proposed Lee 3 Fee No. 7H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4SE/4 (Unit O) to a standard bottom hole location in the NW/4NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 3.

The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.


