STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Anschutz Oil Company, LLC seeks an order approving a 640-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Mancos formation comprised of the W/2 of Section 14 and E/2 of Section 15, Township 25 North, Range 2 West, N.M.P.M. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Mancos formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for any formations and/or pools developed on 640 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Gavilan-Mancos Pool. Applicant has drilled its Regina Com. 25-2-14-15 Well No. 1H to a depth sufficient to test the Gavilan-Mancos Pool. It is a horizontal well drilled from a surface location in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 14, with a terminus

in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 15. The beginning of the producing interval is 893.3 feet from the north line and 2291.4 feet from the west line of Section 14, with a terminus 859.6 feet from the north line and 1821 feet from the east line of Section 15. The partially unorthodox location was previously approved. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Anschutz Exploration Corporation as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
