COG Operating LLC ("COG") submits its Pre-Hearing Statement pursuant to the rules of the Oil Conservation Division.

COG is the applicant in this case. Its business address is 550 W. Texas Avenue, Suite 100, Midland, Texas 79701. COG is represented by the undersigned counsel.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

COG's application seeks an order (i) approving a 160-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 21, Township 25 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., in Lea County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this average. The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Coachman Fec Com #4H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit D of Section 21, Township 25 South, Range 35 East to a bottom hole location in Unit M of Section 21, Township 25 South, Range 35 East. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.


