To Whom It May Concern:

On October 6, 2014, COG Operating LLC ("COG") spud the Graham Nash State Com #6H (the "Well") which is currently producing from the 2nd Bone Spring Sand Formation. The spacing unit, orientation and location information for the Well is described in further detail on the State of New Mexico Energy, Minerals & Natural Resources Department Form C-102 enclosed herewith.

Also enclosed herewith is a copy of the Offer to Lease ("Lease Offer") sent to your attention dated June 21, 2012, whereby COG offered to lease your minerals underlying the NW/4NE/4 Section 28, T26S, R28E, among other lands, which is part of the spacing unit for the Well.

The aforementioned Lease Offer made to you was accepted and payment for all of tracts listed therein was remitted to you in the amount of:

The Oil and Gas Lease (the "Lease") that was negotiated subject to the Lease Offer was recorded in the Official Public Records of Eddy County, New Mexico in Book 901, Page 702 of same. A copy of the Lease is enclosed herewith for your reference.

Following the recording of the Lease it has been discovered that the legal description in the Lease inadvertently failed to include the NW/4NE/4 Section 28, T26S, R28E, along with the NE/4NW/4 of Section 28, T26S, R28E (collectively the "Tracts"). Furthermore, the lands listed for Section 19 under the heading for Township 26 South, Range 28 East, should appear under the heading for Township 26 South, Range 29 East.

The inadvertent failure to include the Tracts on the Lease resulted in an overpayment of each being made with regard to the respective mineral interests intended to be covered by the Lease.

In an effort to resolve the above-described issues with the Lease Offer, subsequently recorded Lease, and the overpayment tendered for same, COG hereby proposes the following options:

- 1.) Amendment of the Lease to include the missing Tracts; or

- 2.) Participation in the Well with any applicable net revenue payable being offset by the amount equal to the overpayment tendered to you upon execution of the Lease.

An Amendment to Oil and Gas Lease (the "Amendment") is included herewith for your review. Should you elect to amend the Lease please indicate same in the space provided herein below and execute, notarize and return the copy of the enclosed Amendment along with your election to amend the Lease to my attention.

In the alternative, should you wish to participate in the Well please indicate your election to participate in the Well in the space provided for herein below along with an executed copy of the Authority for Expenditure that is enclosed herewith and return them to my attention. COG will provide under separate cover a 1989 A.A.P.L. Form 610 Model Form Operating Agreement governing operations for the Well for you to execute and return.

A response indicating your election to amend the Lease or to participate in the Well is due no later than thirty (30) days from the receipt of this letter.

Please be advised that a failure to respond to this letter will require COG to initiate compulsory pooling proceedings against your respective interests before the Oil Conservation Division of the State of New Mexico Energy Minerals & Natural Resources Department. Notice of the compulsory pooling proceedings will be sent to you in a separate letter.


