3 Application of COG Operating LLC for a non-standard oil
4 spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea
5 County, New Mexico.

6 Notice for appearance.

7 MR. LARSON: Mr. Examiner, Gary Larson of the
8 Santa Fe Office of Hinkle, Shanor, for applicant COG
9 Operating.

10 Mr. Examiner, at the previous hearing in
11 this case on May 14th, an issue arose concerning the
12 timing of COG's publication notice for that hearing,
13 which resulted in the case being continued.

14 Subsequently, COG republished notice
15 providing publication notice of today's hearing. Marked
16 as Exhibit 11 is an affidavit of publication by Daniel
17 Russell, who is the publisher of the Hobbs News-Sun. The
18 affidavit states that the hearing notice was published
19 on May 20th, which is 15 business days prior to today.

14 is taken under advisement.

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
