APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order (i) approving a non-standard 560 acre horizontal well project area in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the N $\frac{1}{2}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico (the "Project Area"), and (ii) approving two unorthodox oil well locations, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in the Project Area, and has the right to drill a well or wells thereon.
2. The Project Area is comprised entirely of federal lands, and the Bureau of Land Management (the "BLM") required applicant to form and communitize the Project Area. The Project Area, as to the Bone Spring formation, is subject to Communitization Agreement dated May 15, 2014, approved by the BLM (No. NM 134237), and recorded at Book 1014, page 849 of the Lea County Records. All working interest owners have executed Communitization Agreement NM 134237.
3. Applicant has drilled or is currently drilling the following wells in the Project Area:

Leo 15 DA Fed. Com. Well No. 1H

Leo 15 B2DH Fed. Com. Well No. 1H

Leo 15 B2DP Fed. Com. Well No. 1H

Leo 15 B2DN Fed. Com. Well No. 1H

All acreage in the Project Area will be fully developed.


4. The following wells have unorthodox locations exterior to the Project Area:
 - (a) Leo 15 B2DH Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a surface location 430 feet from the north line and 370 feet from the west line, and a bottomhole location 2600 feet from the north line and 330 feet from the east line, of Section 15.
 - (b) Leo 15 B2DN Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a surface location 630 feet from the north line and 370 feet from the west line, and a bottomhole location 330 feet from the south line and 2600 feet from the west line, of Section 15.

The BLM has required that all surface locations for wells in the Project Area be located in the NW4NW/4 of Section 15.

5. Approval of the non-standard project area and the unorthodox well locations will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order granting the relief requested herein.
