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STATEMENT OF THE CASE

XTO Energy Inc. seeks an order (1) creating a 239.47-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 29 East and the E/2 SE/4 of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, Willow Lake; Bone Spring, Southeast (Pool Code 96217), underlying this acreage. This proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the proposed **Golden Corral 6 State No. 1H** Well, which will be horizontally drilled from

a surface location in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 6 (Unit P) to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 31. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.


