

Jost, and Cecil Bohannon: Chi Energy, Inc. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Wolfcamp formation to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the E/2 of Section 7, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Bermuda Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox gas well location in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 7. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Chi Operating, Inc. as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The applico-

tion is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, October 6, 2005 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
