APPLICATION

YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION ("Yates"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving its Milsap State Exploratory Unit and in support of this application states:

1. The proposed Unit Area consists of 2240 acres, more or less, of State of New Mexico lands, situated in Lea County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

Township 12 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 25: All
Section 36: All

Township 12 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 31: All

Township 13 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 6: N2

2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

3. The Applicant, Yates Petroleum Corporation, is designated as Unit Operator in said Unit Agreement and all oil and gas in all formations are unitized.


4. The unit boundaries are consistent and substantially supported by the geological limits of the unitized formations.

5. Said Unit Agreement and the unitized operation and management of the Unit Area will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste, and that it will protect the correlative rights of all parties concerned.

WHEREFORE, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on November 17, 2005, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Milsap State Exploratory Unit be approved.
