Tuck, Jr., Larry Turner, and Sahde Wische: Unit Petroleum Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from 4000 feet subsurface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S/2 of Section 29, Township 22 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, and in the following manner: The S/2 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 320 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Dublin Ranch-Atoka Gas Pool and Dublin Ranch-Morrow Gas Pool; the SE/4 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the NE/4SE/4 to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the

Herradura Bend-Cherry Canyon Pool and Herradura Bend-Delaware Pool. The units are to be dedicated to the Toles Fed. Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox gas well location in the NE/4SE/4 of Section 29. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
