APPLICATION

GRUY PETROLEUM MANAGEMENT COMPANY ("Gruy"), through its undersigned attorneys, pursuant to Oil Conservation Division Rule 104.D (3), hereby makes application for an order authorizing the simultaneous dedication of the following two wells located in the NW/4 of Section 10, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to the 160-acre spacing and proration unit in the Rhodes Yates-Seven Rivers Gas Pool comprised of the NW/4 of said Section 10:

- A. Cagle C Federal Com Well No. 6 ("Cagle Well No. 6") located in Unit C at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1977 feet from the West line; and
- B. Rhodes Federal Unit Well No. 102 (API No. 30-025-24537) (RFU Well No. 102") located in Unit E at an standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line.

In support of its application, Gruy states:

1. Gruy is the operator of a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Rhodes Yates-Seven Rivers Gas Pool comprised of the NW/4 of Section 10, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Gruy's RFU Well No. 102 located in Unit E of said Section 10 currently produces from the Yates Seven-Rivers formation, Rhodes Yates-Seven Rivers Gas Pool.
2. Gruy's RFU Well No. 102 is not efficiently producing the reserves under this spacing unit.
3. To produce the reserves under this spacing unit, Gruy seeks an exception to the provisions of Division Rule 104.D(3) for its Cagle Well No. 6 which it proposes to drill at a standard

location in Unit C of Section 10 for the production of hydrocarbons from the Yates-Seven Rivers formation.

4. The simultaneous dedication of the NW/4 of said Section 10 to the Cagle Well No. 6 and the RFU Well No. 102 will afford Gruy the opportunity to efficiently produce the Yates-Seven Rivers formation under this spacing and proration unit, thereby protecting its correlative rights. The correlative rights of no other owner in this reservoir will be adversely affected.


5. Notice of this application has been provided to those affected parties identified on the Notification List marked Exhibit A and attached hereto.

6. Approval of this application will result in the efficient recovery of hydrocarbons from the Rhodes Yates-Seven Rivers Gas Pool, thereby preventing waste, and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation.

WHEREFORE, Gruy Petroleum Management Company requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on October 6, 2005 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order approving the simultaneous dedication of the NW/4 of Section 10, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, to the Cagle C Federal Com Well No. 6 and the RFU Well No. 102.


Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Gruy Petroleum Management Company has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking authorization to simultaneously dedicate a standard 160-acre spacing or proration unit in the Rhodes Yates-Seven Rivers Gas Pool comprised of the NW/4 of Section 10, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, to its Cagle C Federal Com Well No. 6 and its RFU Well No. 102.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on October 6, 2005. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall at the Division's Santa Fe offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.
