

## APPLICATION

Comes now, CHAMA PETROLEUM COMPANY, by and through its undersigned attorneys and, as provided by Section 70-2-17, New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1978 Compilation, hereby makes application for an order pooling all of the mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation in and under the S/2 of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show the Division:

- 1. Applicant owns or represents approximately 87.5% of the working interest in and under the S/2 of Section 23 and applicant has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced pooled unit to the Chama Parino No. 1 well to be drilled at an unorthodox location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 23.
- 3. The only interest owner who has not agreed to pool her interest for the drilling of the proposed well is Claire Parino, the owner of a 12.5% mineral interest under the S/2 of Section 23.

- 4. Said pooling of interests and well completion will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
- 5. In order to permit the applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interest should be pooled, and applicant should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before the Division's duly appointed examiner, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including provisions for applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, and its costs of supervision while drilling, and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well, and making such other and further provisions as may be proper in the premises.
