APPLICATION

Yates Petroleum Corporation ("Yates") files this application for an order approving it's Wolverine Federal State Exploratory Unit. In support of its application, Yates states:

1. The proposed Unit Area for the Wolverine Federal State Exploratory Unit consists of approximately 2,230.96 acres of State and Federal lands in Lea County, New Mexico, comprised of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, N.M.P.M.

Section 6: Lots 6, 7, E/2 SW/4 and SE/4 (S/2)
Section 7: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, E/2 W/2, E/2 (All)
Section 17: All
Section 18: All

2. Yates is the designated operator under the Unit Agreement and the unitized interval is surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation.

3. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.


4. Yates has met with the New Mexico State Land Office and the Bureau of Land Management and agreed upon the form of the Unit Agreement.

5. Approval of this Application is in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
