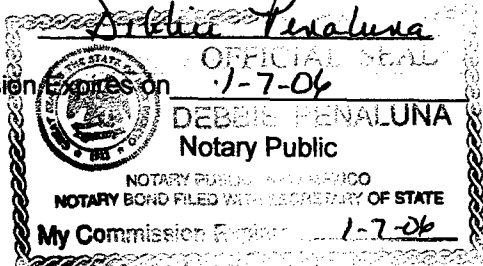

Production Company, L.P. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an exception to Rule 19.15.5.303A NMAC to authorize the surface commingling of production from the Northeast Red Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool and the Red Lake Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool originating from its wells located on Federal Oil and Gas Leases NM 033865, NM 29270, NM 056122, LC 026874(b), NM 025528, NM 0557370, LC 064050(a), and LC 067849 which comprise all or parts of Sections 33, 34, and 35, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant also seeks an exception to the metering requirements of Rule 19.15.5.303B(4)(a) NMJAC to authorize the allocation of production from these diversely-owned wells on the basis of periodic well tests. All production from these wells is to be stored at the Eagle "34" Tank Battery, located in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 34. This matter is scheduled for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, January 19, 2006 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the leases, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a latter date. The leases and wells are located approximately 8 miles East-Northeast of Atoka, New Mexico. IN THE ABSENCE OF OBJECTION, THIS MATTER WILL BE TAKEN UNDER ADVISEMENT.
