

<b>CASE 15433: Application of Matador Production Company for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico.</b> Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed <b>Eland State 32-185-33E RN No. 123H Well</b> , which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) to a standard bottom hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 32.
