On March 17, 2016, I presented testimony at the Oil Conservation Division docket hearing as a petroleum geologist for COG Operating LLC. Pursuant to your request at the hearing for additional information, please find below a description of the oil gravity, GOR, and oil characteristics in the Wolfcamp adjacent to the proposed non-standard spacing unit for the Admiral Federal Com No. 2H Well.

- The oil gravity for the area is 48° API.
- The GOR for the area is 2,450 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil.
- The color of the oil in the area is yellow.
