2 MR. BRANCARD: I can just update the
3 Commission a little bit about litigation. And as you're
4 aware, the Pit Rule case is now over and done with. The
5 Court of Appeals issued an opinion in our -- supporting
6 your decision, and then the Supreme Court refused to
7 hear the case in very quick order.

8 CHAIRPERSON CATANACH: So that's done.

9 MR. BRANCARD: It's done.

10 We're still waiting to hear from the Court
11 of Appeals about the other two appeals of the 2008 and
12 2009 rule, which they had indicated to the parties that
13 they had an order to show cause why they shouldn't just
14 throw them out, but they haven't acted on it yet.

15 COMMISSIONER BALCH: So in all likelihood,
16 those are going to be dismissed?

17 MR. BRANCARD: Yeah.

18 And then we have the appeal on the
19 Commission's order on the geothermal case. We filed a
20 motion to dismiss that case, and that's been fully
21 briefed. And the Court put us on the rocket docket. We
22 have a hearing in October on the motion to dismiss.

23 CHAIRPERSON CATANACH: Oh, for the motion
24 to dismiss.

25 MR. BRANCARD: Yeah. So nothing on that

1 for a while.

2 COMMISSIONER BALCH: That's the fast one?

3 MR. BRANCARD: That's the fast one.

4 CHAIRPERSON CATANACH: Okay.

5 MR. HALL: Is that the lightning docket?

6 MR. BRANCARD: Yes.

7 CHAIRPERSON CATANACH: Lightning fast.

8 Okay. Any other business?

9 With that, we will adjourn this meeting.

10 MR. HALL: Thanks.
